Charlie Baker: Male, 30-50s A shy, awkward and morose British gentleman. Multiple Dialects.
(Standard British Required)

Sgt. "Froggy" LeSueur : Male, 40-60s British military demolitions expert. Adventurous and cheery.
British or Cockney dialect preferred.

Betty Meeks: Female 60s + Pleasant, good-hearted, "down-home" Southern widow. A bit naïve.
Southern Accent required

Rev. David Lee : Male, 30-49 Charming charismatic young minister who is not what he seems.
Distinguished southern accent

Catherine Sims : Female, 20-30s A wealthy ex-debutante, restless and bored with life. Quick-witted and outspoken.

Owen Musser: Male 20-40 Crude, ignorant, racist & redneck are all words that might be used to describe Owen.

Ellard Sims : Male, 20s Catherine's simple-minded, slow-witted, good natured brother.

REHEARALS BEGIN IN JUNE

After being separated by shipwreck, two sets of twins seek to find one another, leading to a series of confusion and mistaken identity.

Antipholus Of Syracuse: 25-40 years old.

A man who is traveling, in search for his long lost brother. Calm but charismatic. Is often mistook for his brother throughout the play.

Antipholus Of Ephesus: 25-40 years old.

A very well-respected merchant. Married to Adriana. Has a bit of an edge to him and a short fuse with things do not go his way.

Dromio Of Syracuse: 18-35 years old.

Lively and animated. A servant to Antipholus. Also part of a set of twins, both of who serve the respective Antiphilus twins.

Dromio of Ephesus: 18-35 years old.

Lively and animated. A servant to Antipholus. Also part of a set of twins, both of who serve the respective Antiphilus twins.

Adriana: 25-40. Married to Antipholus of Ephesus. Can often be as edgy and short-fused as her husband.

Luciana: 20-35. Adriana's younger sister. Generally more calm and relaxed than her sister. Un-married and is desired by Antipholus of Syracuse.

Egeon: 40+, the imprisoned father of the Antipholus twins

Aemilia: 40+, a religious figure, mother of the Antipholus twins.

Duke Solinus: 30+, the Duke of Ephesus

Balthazar: 20+, Merchant and friend of Antipholus of Ephesus

Angelo: 20+, a goldsmith who makes a chain for Antipholus of Ephesus

Merchant: 20+, friend of Antipholus of Syracuse

Second Merchant: 20+, a merchant who holds a debt for Antipholus

Pinch: 30+, creepy exorcist hired by Adriana

Courtesan: 20+, lady of the night

Gaoler/Officer: 20+, bodyguard or person of authority in service to the Duke.
